



ROUTE 1

Take I-196 W toward Holland and Port Sheldon St. to 160th Ave. in West Olive for 29.6 miles. Continue onto 160th Ave. Drive to Blair St. for 0.7 miles. Arrive at Wuskowhan Players Club, 16111 Blair St., West Olive, Michigan.

ROUTE 2

Get on I-196 W for 0.7 miles. Follow M-45 W/Lake Michigan Dr. NW to 120th Ave. in West Olive for 21.2 miles. Follow 120th Ave. and Port Sheldon St. to Blair St. in Port Sheldon Township for 11.8 miles. Arrive at Wuskowhan. Players Club, 16111 Blair St., West Olive, Michigan.

COURSE RULES

Once again, thank you for your participation in the 17th annual *Van Andel Institute Golf Outing*. As a reminder, the practice range opens at 8:30 a.m. with a continental breakfast available.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING VAI GOLF OUTING RULES:

- Proper golf attire is required at all times.
- Gentlemen are requested to remove their hat or cap inside the Clubhouse.
- Gentlemen must wear shirts with collars, and shirttails must be tucked in.
- Women's shirts must have a collar or mock turtleneck if it does not have sleeves.
- Women's shorts or skirts must not be shorter than four inches above the top of their kneecap.
- Denim shorts or pants are not appropriate for men or women.
- Soft-spiked golf shoes are required for all players.
- Cellular phones are not considered appropriate anywhere on the property. Leaving them in your vehicle is strongly encouraged.
- Smoking is not allowed in the Clubhouse. If you smoke on the course, cigar or cigarette butts must be disposed of properly.

Today's event is a four-person scramble. Each player will tee off, and the group will select the best drive. All other players will pick up their ball and hit from where the best drive is located. The team will then play their next shot from that spot. This will continue until the ball is holed out.

VAI GOLF OUTING HIGHLIGHTS:

- Mulligans: Four mulligans can be purchased before tee off for \$100.
- Purple string purchased in advance is used to advance your ball closer to the hole.
 You must cut off the amount you've used until it is gone.
- You may use Kirk Scheerhorn's shot on hole #15. Cost is \$40.
- Longest Drive and Closest to the Pin contests with prizes.
- Hole #18 features our special guest putter this year. You may have the new VP of Philanthropy for VAI, Eric Sturdy, putt for you at no charge.
- Men's and Women's Longest Drive is on holes #1 & #10.
- Men's Closest to the Pin is on holes #4 & #13. Women's is on holes #6 & #15.
- Men will play at the Member's Tees (White).
- Men over 70 may play at the Nature Tees (Green).
- Women will play at the Sanctuary Tees (Red).
- Up for auction is a one-year membership valued at \$30,000 to Dormie Network, a collection of seven private-destination golf clubs in the Midwest and East coast. Perfect for business or leisure, it's the most highly curated overnight experience in private destination golf.
